BYLAW NO. 01 of 2024

A Bylaw of the Village of Liberty in the Province of Saskatchewan Being a Bylaw to Regulate **Dogs Running at Large**

- For the purpose of this bylaw expression: 1.
 - (a) dog shall mean either male or female
 - (b) Municipality shall mean the Village of Liberty
 - (c) Running at large shall mean when the dog is beyond the boundaries of the land occupied by the owner, possessor, or harbourer of the said dog or beyond the boundaries of any lands where it may be with the permission of the owner or occupant of the said land and when it is not under control by being:
 - (i) direct and continuous charge of a person competent to control it; or
 - (ii) securely confined within an enclosure; or
 - (iii) securely fastened so that it cannot roam at will.
- 2. No dog shall run at large in the municipality.
- 3. A person who owns, possesses, or harbours a dog found running at large shall be deemed guilty of an infraction of this bylaw.
- 4. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of sections 2 or 3 of this bylaw, shall be guilty of an offence and upon conviction, shall be liable to a penalty of:

	First Offence	Second Offence	Subsequent Offence
Section 2	\$100.00	\$200.00	\$300.00
Section 3	\$100.00	\$200.00	\$300.00

- (b) A violator of this bylaw, upon being served with a Notice of Violation, may, during office hours, voluntarily pay the penalty at the Village Office, and upon payment as so provided, that person shall not bi liable to prosecution of the offence.
- (c) The Notice of Violation shall be in Schedule A attached to and forming part of this bylaw.
- 5. Bylaw No. 1 of 1990 and 1 of 2007 is hereby repealed.

This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon passing by Council.
